By paying your rent for a minimum of one year automatically through your bank, you will get money credited to your rent account. Pay by standing order and get £25 credited to your account. Our direct debit payment has also increased from £25 to £35!

## Neighbourhood warden service sold to BAA

Thanks to the enterprise of Hounslow
Homes leaseholder Rachel Heydon, local
employer BAA will be buying some of the
successful Neighbourhood Warden Service.
Rachel, who works for BAA as a part of their
Air Side Safety Team at Heathrow, knew that
Hounslow Homes were keen to market the
warden service, and also knew that BAA had a
problem managing some of their land.

Negotiations are now complete for the Neighbourhood Warden scheme to patrol Two Bridges Farm on Hatton Road in Bedfont which is owned and managed by BAA. The area has experienced anti-social behaviour, particularly youth nuisance, which everyone is keen to resolve. The service brings a valuable £7,000 to Hounslow Homes to help support this popular service.

### Making life easier

from George Fry, Chair of the Hounslow Federation of Tenants' and Residents' Associations (HFTRA)



It is great to have the opportunity to talk about the good work that is done every day to make life easier for those of us who are getting older or have a disability. Some people may find that they are starting to have difficulty enjoying their home like they used to; this is where the Occupational Therapist service comes in.

Hounslow Council provides the Occupational Therapist Service free so that residents of the borough can continue to live in their homes for longer and have their lives made just that little bit easier. It is part of our job at HFTRA to champion the interests of older residents and residents who have a disability, some members of our committee belong to these groups and bring special knowledge about the problems that people face.

It is our view that people should have a range of options for

how they want to live their lives open to them at all times; not the least of these is the ability to continue living independently. Hounslow Homes can make adaptations to your property on the basis of the Occupational Therapist Services' advice so that life is made easier for you.

Access to the service has also recently been improved by making it no longer necessary to be referred to the service by your local doctor. People can refer themselves or help a friend or neighbour get referred.

So if you know someone who is struggling upstairs without a handrail or in need of an improvement to their home, then the Occupational Therapist Service can help. Contact them on 020 8583 3200/3400.

### Did you know...

That disabled leaseholders can apply for financial support to help pay for adaptations to their home?

The disability facilities grant can help pay for:

- Adaptations making it easier to get into and out of your home, for example, widening doors and installing ramps
- · Stairlifts
- · Ground floor bathrooms or shower rooms
- · Improving or providing a heating system in your home
- · Adapting heating or lighting controls to make them easier to use

The financial support you get will depend on how much Social Services' assessors decide you need. They will look at how much you, or your partner, can afford without a grant. In the case of a disabled child, they will look at their parent/s income. The grant will then make up the extra money needed to meet the cost of the works.

If you think you might qualify for this grant, contact Social Services' Occupational Therapist on 020 8583 3200/3400. They will arrange a visit to assess your needs.

## "Being a board member means I know what's really going on"

Ou may have read about our tenant board member, Robert Charig, in the last newsletter. This month we speak to Margaret Alveiro who has been a board member since September 2003.

Margaret was born in nearby Richmond and has lived in Feltham, with her American husband for nine years. She loves crosswords and quiz shows. Margaret first decided to become a board member when she felt unhappy about youth nuisance in her area.

"I live on a really nice estate but we do have some problems. I think that some of the youngsters don't have much to do, which means they sometimes get into trouble", she says.

Margaret likes being a board member as she has a better idea of what is happening and she likes sorting out problems.

"Before I became a board member, I thought all Hounslow Homes did was collect the rent and do

repairs. You wouldn't believe all the other stuff that goes on behind the scenes," she says.



Margaret has got involved in the new disability forum, west and central area forums, personnel group, repairs group and housing management working group.

One of the things Margaret wants to do is use her influence to tackle anti-social behaviour.

"I want Hounslow Homes to find out what young people want and care about. Then, they can understand how to make them feel a part of the community." A new programme to do just that is underway in Brentford.

#### **Latest on Decent Homes - Improvements and** modernisation

The draft capital programme for 2005/06 to 2008/09 is included as an insert in this edition of Hounslow Homes News. Your views are invited. Please let your Tenant Liaison Officer or your Area Housing Office know if you have any comments to make. The insert includes information on a new

scheme called Decent Estates.

The detailed programme for 2005/06 will be finalised in the New Year before it is put before the Board for consideration.

The final programme for 2005/06 and the draft programmes for 2006/07 to 2008/09 will then be re-issued to all residents.

### The inspectors are back!

The Audit Commission's Housing Inspectors will again be visiting Hounslow in February to check on the quality of Hounslow Homes' services to tenants and leaseholders. Readers will remember that they last visited two years ago when they awarded our service two stars with promising prospects for improvement. On the strength of this result, **Hounslow Homes** received an additional

£100 million to spend on improving the housing stock.

A small team of inspectors, including a tenant inspector, will be arriving on the 2lst February 2005 and will be in the borough for about two weeks. They will be contacting a small number of residents to ask for their views on **Hounslow Homes'** services. This could be prior to their visit to the borough.
