Housing Management Forums

What is a housing management forum?

There are three housing management forums – one for each area. These are where residents, members of staff, and councillors get together to look at Hounslow Homes' performance. The forums also have a say in how money should be spent to improve their area.

What sort of things would I be involved in?

You will investigate the reasons behind any poor performance; you will also look for the reasons why things are going right. In this way you help improve the way services are provided.

If I was involved, what would I do?

You will be looking at performance reports from all areas and giving your opinions. You will be challenging managers and contractors - the people that provide you services.

How much of my time would it take?

Forums meet four times a year, but you will need to attend a pre-forum meeting each time to go through the paper work with other residents in preparation for the main meeting.
