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Sheltered housing in the London Borough of Hounslow

About this booklet

This booklet tells you about all the sheltered housing schemes in Hounslow. It includes schemes run by Housing Associations, as well as ones run by the Council.

If you apply to move to sheltered housing, an employee of the Council or one of the Housing Associations will arrange to visit you. They will be able to tell you more about sheltered housing, about the choice of different schemes and other options that might better suit your needs. You may also be able to apply for sheltered accommodation in other West London Boroughs under a scheme called Locata.

They will also complete a form to record your current needs, which will be put to the Special Needs Panel to consider. The panel is made up of representatives from the Sheltered Housing Management Team and the Occupational Therapy Department who give professional advice to Housing staff on whether sheltered accommodation is appropriate to meet the individual needs of each applicant.

How to use the booklet

On the back of this booklet there is a map of the London Borough of Hounslow showing the location of all the schemes. Each scheme has been given a number, and the key to the map shows the name of each scheme and the number given to it.

How much rent will I pay?

The charge for rent varies between schemes, but is about £40 - £50 per week and is reviewed each year. You may be able to get help with paying some or all of the rent by claiming Housing Benefit. In addition to the rent you will have to pay for the support services you receive from the Sheltered Scheme Manager and the community alarm scheme called 'support charge', you may be able to get help with the payment of all or part of the support charge from the 'Fairer Charging team'.

Please note that Council Tax is charged separately for the selfcontained 1 and 2 bedroom flats in our schemes.

How long will I wait?

How long you wait can vary from a few months to several years. It depends on the priority you have been given and how many other people are waiting for the same schemes as you have chosen. We have shown the number of vacancies we expect for each scheme in the course of a year, based on the number of vacancies we have had over the last couple of years. Often the number of people waiting is far greater than the number of vacancies, which may mean a very long wait. You are unlikely to be successful in a bid for the most popular schemes unless you have a very high priority. The person who visits you will be able to advise you on which schemes to choose if you want a guicker offer, and which schemes are very popular and therefore have long waits.

The role of the Scheme Manager

Most of the sheltered schemes have a full-time resident Scheme Manager. They work a 36 hour week over 5 days in every week. They do not work on Sundays and have every other Saturday

Who is eligible?

You are eligible to apply for Sheltered Housing if you live in the London Borough of Hounslow and are 60 years of age or over and require housing related support.

If you live outside the London Borough of Hounslow but your local council is a member of the Locata Scheme, you will be able to bid for properties using that Scheme.

If you live in any other council area at the moment, please contact your local council to request a nomination to this borough via the H.O.M.E.S. Scheme instead.

Very Sheltered Schemes

There are 2 such schemes in the London Borough of Hounslow, which have a member of staff on duty 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, offering a higher level of assistance for tenants who are more frail. Applications for housing to these schemes are made in the same way as for our general sheltered housing schemes. or a day during the week off too. When the Scheme Manager is on leave, a Scheme Manager from a nearby unit will do the daily round. If the Scheme Manager is ill or away from the scheme for any other reason, Linkline Community Support Wardens cover the scheme instead.

The schemes that do not have a fulltime resident Scheme Manager are covered by Linkline Community Support Wardens permanently.

The Scheme Manager is available at their own scheme or their paired scheme, from 9 - 12 noon daily. Availability at other times is arranged for the requirements of each scheme. The Scheme Manager is also available for emergencies whenever they are in the building, except on their days off.

The Scheme Manager visits tenants daily and checks on their general wellbeing. They may need to contact the tenant's GP, family or Social Services or other organisations if the tenant needs assistance. The Scheme Manager will also meet with individual tenants to identify their support needs and provide a support plan which will be reviewed every six months. The Scheme Manager may provide extra assistance for a temporary period if a tenant is ill or recently returned home from hospital. This extra help may include shopping, collecting the tenant's pension, advising on or completing forms, etc.

The Scheme Manager also encourages the use of the communal facilities and promotes social events according to the wishes of the tenants of the scheme. General events include coffee mornings, bingo evenings, video screenings, chair aerobics and evening suppers with entertainment, but these vary considerably from scheme to scheme.

Communal laundry facilities

All sheltered housing schemes have communal laundries for the use of the tenants. The laundries have washers & driers and are free of charge to tenants. The laundries are open during the day, but hours may be restricted to enable Home Carers to do laundry for tenants who have high care needs.

Guest rooms

Some sheltered schemes have Guest Room facilities. This accommodation varies from small rooms with washing facilities to self-contained flats. The charges also vary accordingly.

Guest rooms are for occasional use by visitors to tenants of sheltered schemes, who cannot stop over in the tenant's own flat. No booking will be made for longer than 2 weeks. Some schemes do not have Guest Room facilities, so Scheme Managers of other schemes will try and assist colleagues who have a tenant needing a Guest Room for a visitor.

Pet policy

No dogs are allowed in any London Borough of Hounslow managed sheltered schemes. If you already have a cat, please check with the Scheme Manager to see if it is possible for you to take the cat with you. The decision will be made by the Scheme Manager having taken into account the views of the existing tenants and the layout of the scheme.

Housing Associations operate their own policies and you should check this with those organisations direct.

Danehurst, Brent Lea, Brentford TW8 8HX

Location and transport information

Danehurst is situated near the junction of the River Brent and London Road (A315) and backs onto Syon Park. Bus routes to all parts of the borough run along London Road, which is a few minutes walk away. Brentford Rail station is a short bus ride away and Hounslow East Underground station can be reached within 15 minutes by bus.

There is a small shopping parade, which includes a Post Office, approximately 50 yards away from Danehurst. Alternatively the main shops in Brentford High Street are within walking distance.

There are a variety of churches within the vicinity and a Gurdwara and Mosque in Hounslow can be reached within 30 minutes by bus.

Brentford Health Centre is located in Boston Manor Road. The West Middlesex University Hospital in neighbouring Isleworth is a short bus ride away.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from C.C.T.V. security, central heating, a lift, a fully equipped laundry room, and a well-presented communal garden. On the first floor residents have access to a communal kitchen and a communal lounge, which is equipped with T.V., video and a library.
- There are communal toilets and a communal shower on the first floor, which has disabled access and a disabled toilet on the ground floor.
- Car parking is available for residents.
- A variety of social activities are available. These include weekly tea mornings, fortnightly leisure Saturdays, monthly social evenings that include fish & chips, entertainment/education/ outreach presentations. Summer outings are arranged, plus events for special occasions.

Description of the property

Danehurst, built in 1977, is a purpose built 4-storey building containing 44 onebedroom flats, each with its own bathroom and toilet.

Ground floor flat numbers 1, 3, 6, & 9 are adapted for wheelchair use. These are larger flats with low-level units and internal sliding doors. These flats also have access to a front garden.



Fenn House, built in 1980, is a modern 2 storey, purpose built unit containing 39 onebedroom flats. Each flat has its own bathroom and toilet. This Scheme has a part time nonresident Scheme Manager who is available 9am –1.00pm. For the remainder of the time the scheme is supported by Hounslow Linkline service.

Location and transport information

Fenn House is situated in a quiet culde-sac, just off London Road (A315), near to Busch Corner, overlooking Syon Park. Bus routes to all parts of the borough and beyond can be caught a few minutes walk away on London Road and Twickenham Road (bus no's 235, 237, 267, H28, H29, N97). Syon Lane Railway station is 5 minutes walk away and Hounslow East Underground station can be reached by bus (no's H28, 117 or 237) within 15 minutes. The nearest bus stop is approximately 100 yards on the London Road.

Fenn House Lodge Close Isleworth TW7 5BS

Local shops are within walking distance and the nearest shopping centre is a short bus ride away at Brentford High Street. A Post Office on London Road can be reached in a few minutes on foot. There are many places of worship in the area that can be reached easily by public transport.

Brentford Health Centre on Boston Manor Road is a 15 minute bus ride away and the West Middlesex University Hospital is situated in Isleworth.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from well kept communal gardens, a lift, a fully equipped laundry room, 2 communal lounge areas, a piano, and a communal kitchen.
- There are two communal toilets on the ground floor and a communal shower is located on the first floor (medic bath and shower).
- Car parking is available for residents.
- Various social activities are available such as weekly coffee mornings, bingo, mobile hairdresser, parties, summer outings and Christmas parties.

Griffin Court Walnut Tree Road Brentford TW8 0JZ

There is no resident Scheme Manager at this unit but it is covered by the resident Scheme Manager at Harnage House, which is a short distance away.

Location and transport information

Walnut Tree Road is situated off Pottery Road. Brentford High Street is a few minutes walk away, with bus routes to all parts of the borough. Kew Bridge Rail Station can be reached within 5 minutes by bus and South Ealing Underground station is a 15 minute bus ride away.

Shops on Brentford High Street can be reached within 5 minutes by bus. A sub Post Office in Albany Parade is 5 minutes walk away. The Waterman's Arts Centre is within walking distance and the Fountain Leisure Centre is a short bus ride away. A variety of places of worship are within the vicinity.

Brentford Health Centre is located in Boston Manor Road .The nearest hospital is the West Middlesex University Hospital in neighbouring Isleworth.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- Griffin Court benefits from central heating, a lift, a fully equipped laundry room, a communal lounge, a communal kitchen and a communal garden. Car parking is available for residents.
- All social activities are arranged with the sheltered residents in neighbouring Harnage House, Brentford. These range from coffee mornings, bingo sessions and video afternoons.

Description of the property

Griffin Court, built in 1967, is a four storey, modern building consisting of 16 one bedroom flats and 2 flats specifically adapted for wheelchair use, one of which has 2 bedrooms. Each flat has its own bathroom and WC.

The flats on the ground floor are wheelchair accessible. Flats above the ground floor have shared balconies. In 1995 this scheme was totally refurbished.

Harnage House, built in 1974, is a three-storey building containing 40 one-bedroom flats. Each flat has its own bathroom and toilet.

Location and transport information

Clayponds Lane is situated off Ealing Road. Brentford High Street, which is approximately 10–15 minutes walk away, has bus routes to all parts of the borough and beyond (bus numbers 65, 237 and 267). South Ealing Underground station can be reached in approximately 10 minutes with the No. 65 bus. The nearest Railway station is Brentford.

Local shops situated in Netley Road can be reached in 5 minutes by foot. The main shops in Ealing Broadway can be reached within 15 minutes with the 65 bus. The nearest Post Office is in Albany Parade, which is 15 minutes walk away. The Watermans Arts Centre can be reached easily on foot and the Fountain Leisure Centre is a short bus

ride away. A range of churches can be found locally. A Mosque and a Gurdwara in Hounslow can be reached by public transport.

Brentford Health Centre is in Boston Manor Road and the nearest hospital is the West Middlesex University Hospital in neighbouring Isleworth.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from a communal garden with patio area, a large communal lounge equipped with a T.V. and a music system, a fully equipped laundry room, and a pay phone.
- There are two communal toilets on the ground floor. Additional bathing facilities are available on the first floor with two communal showers that are suitable for wheelchair users.
- Car parking is available for residents.
- Various social activities are organised. These include bingo sessions, coffee mornings, video afternoons, Baptist prayer services and a library service once a month.

Jessop House Kirton Close Chiswick W4 5UX

Location and transport information

Kirton Close is situated off Chiswick High Street and behind Chiswick Health Centre. Several bus routes run through Chiswick High Street. The nearest bus stop is approximately 500 yards away. Chiswick Park and Turnham Green Underground stations are both approximately 10 minutes walk away.

Jessop House is conveniently placed within walking distance of Chiswick High Street with its many shops; an added bonus is a Sainsburys supermarket, which is 5 minutes walk away. The nearest library is 10 minutes walk away on Dukes Road and the nearest Post Office is 5 minutes walk away. Catholic and Anglican churches can be found nearby. A Mosque in Shepherds Bush, Uxbridge Road, can be reached by public transport and a Gurdwara in Hounslow is also accessible by public transport.

Chiswick Health Centre is on Fishers Lane and can be reached on foot. Charing Cross Hospital in neighbouring Hammersmith can be reached easily by bus or London Underground.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from, central heating, a lift, a communal garden, a communal laundry room, a communal kitchen, and a comfortable communal lounge equipped with T.V., music system and library.
- Communal shower facilities are available on the 1st and 2nd floors. These showers are walk-in therefore making them suitable for disabled use.
- Car parking is available for residents.
- A variety of social activities are available at Jessop House. These include bingo twice a week, coffee morning, Thursday club, hairdresser (fortnightly), fish & chips meals, bring & buy, keep fit weekly, afternoon tea, parties and a drop-in-club- for Chiswick pensioners run by a volunteer and the Scheme Manager.

Description of the property

Jessop House, built in 1980, is a 3-storey building containing 40 one bedroom flats and 1 bedsit (no.12). Each property has its own bathroom and toilet.

The flats on the first and second floors have balconies.

The ground floor flats have their own patio area.



Lambert Lodge, built in 1982, is a 3-storey purpose built building, containing 38 onebedroom flats, each with its own bathroom and WC.

Location and transport information

Lambert Lodge is situated on a quiet, small estate, off the Ealing Road. Brentford Rail Station is approximately 10 minutes walk away and several bus stops are situated within 10 - 20 minutes walk. The nearest bus stop is the E2 bus stop on Windmill Road. The other bus routes include the E8 from Half Acre Road and the 65 from Ealing Road.

Several places of worship can be found within the vicinity.

Local shops are situated on Windmill Road and there are bus routes to the main shops in Chiswick or Hounslow. A Post Office is located on London Road, with a Sub Post Office at the Albany Road shopping parade.

Brentford Health Centre is on Boston Manor Road and the nearest hospital is the West Middlesex University Hospital in Isleworth.

Lambert Lodge Layton Road Brentford TW8 0PT

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme surrounds a courtyard garden and benefits from central heating, a lift, a fully equipped laundry & drying room, two communal lounges equipped with T.V., piano, library, a communal kitchen and a large well-kept communal garden.
- Two communal toilets are located on the ground floor. A communal shower can be found on the first floor.
- A pay phone on the ground floor is available for residents' use.
- Car parking is available for residents.
- A variety of social activities are arranged, these include coffee mornings three times a week, bingo once a week, social evenings, mobile clothes shop twice a year, coach outings to the coast/cathedrals twice a year, a Methodist church service once a month and a Christmas party. Other outings are also arranged together with other sheltered units.

Loraine Road Chiswick W4 3QT

This scheme does not have a resident scheme manager. Tenants receive a daily visit from Monday to Saturday from a relief warden and are supported by the Hounslow Linkline service at all other times.

Location and transport information

Local shops and a Post office are within 7 minutes walk in Thames Road. Various places of worship are located nearby. These include The Church Of England church at Grove Park (5 mins), a Catholic Church at Chiswick High Road, an Iranian Church at Grove Park, and a Russian Orthodox at Sutton Court Road. A Synagogue is located in Chiswick High Road, Hammersmith. A Mosque on Uxbridge Road in Shepherds Bush can be reached by public transport and a Gurdwara in Hounslow is also accessible by public transport.

The nearest hospitals are Charing Cross Hospital in Hammersmith and the West Middlesex University Hospital in Isleworth. The local GP surgery can be found in Burlington Lane and is approximately 10 minutes walk. There is also a health centre in Grove Park Gardens. The nearest bus stop is approximately 10 minutes walk away.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- Communal shower facilities (that are wheelchair accessible) are situated near the scheme manager's office.
 Loraine Road has a communal kitchen, a fully equipped laundry room and a communal garden for residents to use.
- Street parking outside properties.
- Social activities are available at other nearby sheltered units.

Description of the property

Loraine Road offers 27 one bedroom flats that have undergone refurbishment, completed in June 2000. The flats are street access properties on the ground and first floors. Each flat has its own bathroom and WC. The ground floor flats, totalling 13, have ramped access making them suitable for wheelchair users.

There is also some mixed accommodation in Loraine Road, which includes some adapted three-bedroom properties that are for families with special needs.

The Maltings, built in 1960, is a four storey building made up of two 2 bedroom flats, six one bedroom flats and 14 bedsits.

The bedsits have individual WCs' and shared bathrooms.

The one-bedroom flats have individual bathrooms.

There are a total of five flats on each floor, 2 of which are 1-bedroom flats.

The first and second floors have balconies.

There is no resident Scheme Manager at this development. This unit receives a daily service (Monday-Saturday) from the community support wardens based at Hounslow Linkline.

Location and transport information

Spring Grove is situated off the Strand on the Green and close to Kew Gardens. Several bus routes serve this area with a bus stop located only a few minutes walk from the sheltered unit (5 mins). Kew Bridge Rail station is approximately 5 minutes walk away and Gunnersbury Underground station can be reached in about 15 minutes by bus.

Local shops are walking distance away, or alternatively the main shops at Chiswick High Road or Brentford High Street can be reached by bus. There is a Post Office at 1 Heathfield Terrace and a Sub Post Office at 1 Chiswick High Road.

Various places of worship are within the vicinity. These include a Catholic Church at Chiswick High Road and a Russian Orthodox at Sutton Court Road. A Synagogue is located in Chiswick High Road, Hammersmith and a Church of England church at Grove

Park. A Mosque on Uxbridge Road in Shepherds Bush, can be reached by public transport and a Gurdwara in Hounslow is also accessible by public transport.

Medical facilities are available at Chiswick Health Centre in Fishers Lane or the nearest GP surgery can be found in Wellesley Road.

The nearest hospitals are Charing Cross Hospital in Hammersmith and the West Middlesex University Hospital in Isleworth.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- The scheme benefits from central heating, a lift, a communal lounge equipped with a T.V. and music system, a communal kitchen, communal laundry facilities, and a communal garden. Residents also have access to a communal car parking area.
- Communal walk-in showers are located on each floor.
- Social activities are available in the unit such as coffee mornings and bingo. Other outings are arranged together with other sheltered housing units.

Meadowcroft Brooks Road Chiswick W4 3BD

Location and transport information

Meadowcroft is set in a quiet residential area of Wellesley Road. The nearest bus stop can be found in Wellesley road. Buses run locally to destinations including Shepherds Bush, Hammersmith and Hounslow.

Several small shops can be found nearby on Chiswick High Road, by Kew Bridge or on Thames Road. There are also local shops at the Strand–on-the-Green that can be reached by a footpath over the railway bridge.

There is a local library in Dukes Avenue and Post Offices on Heathfield Terrace and Chiswick High Road. The Fountain Leisure Centre is also nearby.

There are various places of worship in and around Chiswick. These include the following, a Catholic Church on Chiswick High Road, an Anglican Church in Turnham Green, a Baptist Church on Wellesley Road, a Greek Orthodox in Chiswick Village, a Russian Orthodox on Sutton Court Road and an Iranian Church in Grove Park. A Mosque on Uxbridge Road, Shepherds Bush, can be reached by public transport and Gurdwaras in Hounslow and Southall areas are also accessible by public transport. A Synagogue can be found on the Chiswick High Road, Hammersmith.

The nearest GP is located on Wellesley Road. There is also the Chiswick Health Centre in Fishers Lane.



Charing Cross Hospital in neighbouring Hammersmith can be reached by bus or London Underground.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from central heating, a lift, a communal lounge equipped with a T.V. and library area, a communal kitchen, a communal laundry room, well-kept communal gardens, a communal patio and conservatory area.
- There is a small car parking area available for residents.
- On the ground floor there are two showers and a bath. On the first and second floors there are walk–in showers suitable for wheelchair users, and two baths, which may be used by tenants.
- A small number of the bedsits have had showers installed.
- Various social activities are arranged e.g. coffee mornings, summer parties and Christmas dinners.

Description of the property

Meadowcroft, built in 1975, is a pleasant 3storey building with a total of 26 bedsits and 10 one-bedroom flats.

There are 4 onebedroom flats on the ground floor adapted for people who use a wheelchair.

Melody Court was the first sheltered scheme built by Ealing Family in 1983.

It comprises 39 tenants' flats, a Scheme Manager's flat, a guest flat, laundry and tenants' lounge with adjoining kitchen.

There is also a shower room for tenants or carers to use.

The flats are all one bedroom and self-contained.

There are 4 flats that are purpose built for people who need to use a wheelchair on a daily basis. This scheme is owned and managed by Ealing Family Housing Association. People registered on the local Housing Register are put forward to a proportion of vacancies made available to Hounslow Council.

Location and transport information

Chiswick Town Hall, Social Services, and the library are to be found at the Chiswick end of Wellesley Road, one mile away. There is a local Post Office at 561 High Road. The main Post Office is on Heathfield Terrace, near the Town Hall. There is a small corner shop almost next door, which is open until ten p.m. at night.

The nearest Underground station is Gunnersbury, which is also a Rail Station. Kew Bridge Station is a tenminute walk, with trains to Waterloo. Buses 237; 267; 391; and H91 go to local destinations and for those unable to use public transport, the 'Taxi – Card' scheme and 'Dial - a- Ride' are available.

There are various places of worship in the vicinity. These include a Catholic Church on Chiswick High Road, an Anglican Church in Turnham Green, a Greek Orthodox in Chiswick Village, a Russian Orthodox on Sutton Court Road and an Iranian Church in Grove Park. A Synagogue can be found on the Chiswick High Road, Hammersmith.

Melody Court Wellesley Road Chiswick W4 3AD

A Mosque on Uxbridge Road, Shepherds Bush, can be reached by public transport. Gurdwaras in Hounslow and Southall are also accessible by public transport.

Chiswick Health Centre is located in Fisher's Lane. Charing Cross Hospital in neighbouring Hammersmith can be reached by bus or London Underground.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- There are two washing machines and driers for tenants' use. A hairdresser calls weekly. A greengrocers van calls every Friday afternoon, and there are mobile clothes shows and entertainment throughout the year. There is a fully enclosed garden at the rear of the premises, for the exclusive use of residents of Melody Court.
- The guest flat accommodates two adults and two children: it is available for tenant's relatives to stay in emergencies and other circumstances, at the discretion of Ealing Family Housing Association.
- The following social activities are available: two or three coach trips per year; mini afternoon outings to places of interest; bingo twice a week; film shows; Christmas and Summer parties, etc.

Boswood Court Ede Close Hounslow TW3 3EY

Location and transport information

Ede Close is located off Bath Road. Sutton Lane and Wellington Road North are a few minutes walk away, with bus routes running from these roads to all parts of the Borough. Hounslow West Underground station is approximately 10 minutes walk away.

A sub Post Office is located a few minutes walk away, and local shops are a short bus ride away. Hounslow High Street with its many shops and a library (in the Treaty Centre) can be reached in 10 minutes by bus.

Various places of worship can be found nearby including churches, a Gurdwara (Hibernia Road), a Mosque (Wellington Road South), and a Synagogue (Staines Road).

The nearest Health Centre is walking distance away in Bath Road and the nearest hospital is the West Middlesex University Hospital in neighbouring Isleworth.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from central heating, a lift, a laundry room, a communal kitchen, a communal lounge and a communal garden.
 Other facilities include a games room on the first floor, together with a sun lounge room.

These include the Isleworth Medical centre in Twickenham Road, St Margaret's Medical Centre, St Margaret's Road, Twickenham, and the Cole Park Medical Centre on Twickenham Road. The West Middlesex University Hospital is approximately 5 minutes walk away.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- Wynne Court benefits from central heating, a lift, a laundry room, a parking area and communal gardens. Other communal facilities include a communal kitchen and a communal lounge equipped with a T.V. and a library.
- In addition to the main lounge on the ground floor there is a smaller lounge situated on the first floor ideal for quiet reading, relaxation etc.
- Communal bathrooms and walk-in showers are available on all floors. These facilities are shared by approximately 8 to 12 persons.
- Regular social activities are held in the unit such as coffee mornings, bingo, keep fit classes, a sewing club, and entertainment evenings. Day trips to the theatre, coastal areas, and shopping centres are also organised.

Description of the property

Built in 1975, this 3storey purpose built unit is made up of 4 one bedroom flats and 32 bedsits.

Each one bedroom flat has a bathroom and toilet.

The bedsits have individual toilets and shared bathroom facilities.

4 of the flats are adapted for residents with mobility problems.



Burlington Close, built in 1962, comprises of 20 one bedroom flats and 20 studio flats arranged in a 2-storey building.

In addition there are 8 one-bedroom bungalows and 8 studio bungalows.

All properties have their own bathroom and WC.

Location and transport information

Burlington Close is located off Bedfont Green. The bus routes 116, 203, H25 and H26 run from Bedfont Green to various destinations including Hounslow, Hatton Cross, Feltham and Ashford. Hatton Cross Underground station is approximately one mile away and Feltham Rail station is about 2 miles away.

St Mary's Church of England Church is next door to Burlington House and there are various other places of worship just off Feltham High Street. A Mosque and a Gurdwara are located in Hounslow, which can be reached by public transport.

Burlington Close Bedfont Green Bedfont TW14 8JU

The nearest shops can be found in Bedfont, and a local library is situated on the Staines Road. A sub Post Office can also be found on the Staines Road, with the main Post Office in the Feltham shopping centre.

A GP surgery is located nearby in Elm Road or alternatively there is the Grove Village medical centre and the Hatton medical centre within easy reach. The nearest hospital is Ashford & St Peter's in nearby Ashford.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from central heating, a communal parking area and pleasant communal gardens. A communal lounge, kitchen, and laundry room are located in the main building at Burlington House.
- A range of social activities are held at Burlington House, these include coffee mornings, bingo, social evenings once a month and fund raising activities.

Local housing office

David Henry Waring Court Bedfont Green Close Feltham TW14 8PE

This unit belongs to and is managed by a Charitable Trust. However, Hounslow Homes provide the staff and tenants are identified from our local housing register. Successful candidates have to meet certain criteria set by the Committee for the Trust.

Location and transport information

David Henry Waring Court is situated off Staines Road, near to the junction of Bedfont Green Close and Hatchett Road. Staines Road, with its bus routes, is 5 minutes walk away. The H25 and H26 buses go to Feltham Rail station (in approximately 15 minutes) and to Hatton Cross Underground station (in approximately 20 minutes). The 116 bus travels to Hounslow High Street

The nearest local shops are 5 minutes walk away at Bedfont Green. The Feltham shopping centre can be reached in 15 minutes by bus. Bedfont library and a Post Office on Staines Road are a short bus ride away.

St Mary's Church of England Church at Bedfont Green is 5 minutes walk away and a Mosque and a Gurdwara in Hounslow can be reached by public transport.

The nearest doctor's surgery is 5 minutes walk away on Elm Road and Ashford and St. Peter's Hospital in Ashford can be reached within 15 minutes on the 116 bus.



Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from C.C.T.V. security, an electronic gate to enter the grounds, central heating, a laundry and drying room, a lift in the new block (nos. 12 to 29) and a car parking area. A large comfortable communal lounge and kitchen is available on the ground floor together with a library and a pay phone for residents use. Other features include a conservatory and a sun house.
- On the ground floor there is a walkin shower room and a bathroom, and the first floor offers a walk in shower room and a medi bath.
 Approximately 9 people on each floor share these facilities.
- Social activities in the scheme range from coffee mornings, bingo, parties and outings. Throughout the year organised events offer various merchandise for sale.

Description of the property

David Henry Waring Court, built in 1976, is set in exquisite surroundings with extensive green lawns to the front and picturesque communal gardens. The unit is built around a grand mansion house, which incorporates a new block containing 18 one-bedroom flats.

The communal facilities are arranged within the mansion house. The mansion house is due for refurbishment in 2002, when it is planned to build 8 one bedroom flats with their own bathrooms. It is proposed that two of these flats will be adapted for people with special needs.

Local housing office



Edward Pauling House, built in 1987, has an unusual and attractive architectural design, centred around a communal area. The 41 one-bedroom flats (and 1 studio flat) are arranged in a 3 storey modern building. Each flat has its own bathroom and toilet.

The scheme has large corridors enabling good access for persons using a wheelchair or mobility frame. The ground floor flats, totalling 15, are particularly suitable for those who have mobility problems.

The flats situated on the ground floor have access to a garden area, whilst the flats on the first and second floors have a balcony.

Location and transport information

Westmacott Drive is situated just off Bedfont Lane. The H25 bus stop is placed conveniently opposite Edward Pauling House, and travels to Bedfont Green and Feltham Rail Station within 10 minutes, and to Hatton Cross within 20 minutes. The 116-bus route runs to Ashford.

Local shops are within easy walking distance. A sub Post Office on Bedfont Lane can be reached in approximately 5 minutes by foot. The nearest main shopping centre is a short bus ride away at Feltham High Street.

Bedfont library is a short bus ride away on the Staines Road, near to Bedfont Green.

A variety of churches can be found locally and are within walking distance. Places of worship for other religious denominations include a Mosque on Wellington Road South, Hounslow, and a Gurdwara on Hibernia Road, Hounslow, which can both be reached by public transport.

Edward Pauling House Westmacott Drive Bedfont TW14 9RJ

Several doctors' surgeries are within walking distance and the nearest hospital is Ashford & St Peter's in Ashford, which can be reached in 20 minutes by the 116 bus.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- Edward Pauling House benefits from central heating, a lift, a laundry room, a communal garden and a car parking area. A large comfortable communal lounge is the venue for regular social activities. The lounge is equipped with a T.V., an organ, a piano, and incorporates a communal kitchen. A library can be found next to the lounge.
- Oon the ground floor is a walk-in shower room and a bath equipped with a seat. A person in a wheelchair can use both of these facilities. There are two communal toilets on the ground floor, one of which is suitable for a wheelchair user.
- Social activities held at the unit include bingo, coffee mornings, parties, monthly quiz nights and a mobile clothes and book shop. A mobile library visits the unit each month.

Local housing office

Lavender Court Becketts Close Bedfont TW14 0BU

Location and transport information

Becketts Close is off Harlington Road West. The bus stops on Harlington Road West can be reached in approximately 5 minutes by foot. The bus routes nos. 90, 116, 117, 237, 285, and H26 cover most parts of the borough and some surrounding areas. Feltham Rail station and Hatton Cross Underground station are both a short bus ride away.

The local shops and Post Office are 5 minutes walk away on Harlington Road West. A short bus ride will take you to the main shops and the local library on Feltham High Street. Several churches can be found just off Feltham High Street. The nearest Mosque (Wellington Road South, Hounslow) and Gurdwara (Hibernia Road, Hounslow) can be reached within 30 minutes by bus.

There are several doctors' surgeries within walking distance of Lavender Court. The nearest hospital is Ashford & St Peter's in Ashford.

Amenities provided at the scheme

• Lavender Court benefits from central heating, a lift, a fully equipped laundry room and a car parking area. Other communal facilities include a large comfortable lounge equipped with a television, video and music system. Age Concern shares this lounge. In addition to the main lounge there are separate seating areas, for smaller gatherings, available on each floor. A communal kitchen and a pay phone are located on the ground floor.

- A communal shower and a Medi bath are available on the first floor, for people who have difficulty using their own bath. There are also 2 toilets, which are fully accessible for people with disabilities.
- All flats have a bleep system in every room to contact staff in the event of an emergency.
- Dial-a-Ride and Community Transport are available on a regular basis for shopping, outings and social events.
- A wide range of other community support services are also available, including local doctors, dentists and opticians who can visit if required, a local pharmacist with free pick up and delivery, hairdressing, mobile library, lunch club, day centre run by Age Concern, small general store run by Age Concern, and a visiting clothing shop.
- A variety of social activities are organised, including daily coffee mornings, bingo, local shopping trips and theatre trips. In the summer months events such as garden barbecues, bazaars, and bring- andbuy sales take place.
- A garden club operates at Lavender Court, where tenants raise money for plants etc. and can choose to manage their own small plot or contribute towards communal plots.

Description of the property

Lavender Court, built in 1987, is a purpose built 2-storey modern building, containing 29 one bedroom flats, each with its own bathroom and toilet.

Lavender Court is a very sheltered unit with 24 hour staffing cover.

There are a range of professionals to help assist with care needs, including trained social workers who are employed by Social Services.

Local housing office

Owen House, built in 1977, is a purpose built 3-storey modern building, containing 40 one bedroom flats, each with its own bathroom and toilet.

Location and transport information

Shore Close is situated off Bedfont Lane. The H25 bus stop on Bedfont Lane is approximately 5 minutes walk away with destinations to Hanworth or Hatton Cross. Feltham Rail Station can be reached in approximately 5 minutes by bus, and Hatton Cross Underground Station is a 20-minute bus ride away.

Local shops are a few minutes walk away and the nearest Post Office, on Bedfont Lane, can be reached in 5 minutes by foot. Feltham High Street, with the main shops and a library, is a 15-minute bus ride away.

An Anglican church on Bedfont Lane is within walking distance and there are several other churches just off Feltham High Street. The nearest Mosque is at Wellington Road South, Hounslow, and the nearest Gurdwara is at Hibernia Road, Hounslow. Both of these places of worship can be reached by public transport.

There are several local doctors' surgeries nearby and the 116 bus travels to Ashford & St Peters' hospital within 20 minutes.

Owen House Shore Close Bedfont TW14 9QE

Amenities provided at the scheme

- Owen House benefits from central heating, a lift, a large comfortable communal lounge, a communal kitchen, a fully equipped laundry room, pleasant communal gardens, and a car parking area.
- In addition to the main lounge there are three smaller communal lounges on each floor ideal for smaller gatherings.
- Each floor also offers communal bathrooms and/or shower rooms.
- Situated on the ground floor, residents have access to a pay phone, a guest flat, and two communal toilets.
- Social activities are organised regularly by the Scheme Manager and the residents. Activities include bingo, coffee mornings, shows, clothes sales, games and parties. A mobile hairdresser visits the unit weekly. Local outings and holidays are also arranged and a garden fete with a barbecue takes place annually.

Local housing office

Rectory Court Fernside Avenue Hanworth TW13 7QE

Location and transport information

Rectory Court is set in a quiet residential area off Elmwood Avenue. The H25 bus route runs past Elmwood Avenue to Feltham and Hatton Cross. The nearest Rail Station is Feltham (approximately 20 minutes bus ride away). The nearest Underground stations are Hatton Cross and Hounslow West (approximately 30 – 45 minutes bus ride away).

Local shops are conveniently situated opposite Rectory Court. The main shops at Feltham High Street can be reached on the H25 bus. Hanworth Library is on Hampton Road West and a Sub Post Office is situated in Clifton Parade, opposite Rectory Court.

A Church of England church is located next door to Rectory Court and various other Churches and places of worship can be reached in Feltham and Hounslow, including a Mosque and a Gurdwara

There is a GP surgery in Raleigh Way and the Manor Lane Health Centre is off Feltham High Street. The nearest



hospital is Ashford & St Peter's in Ashford.

Amenities provided at the scheme

- This scheme benefits from central heating, a laundry room, a communal garden and access to a communal car parking area. Other facilities include a comfortable communal lounge and kitchen on the ground floor.
- A communal walk-in shower room is available on the ground floor.
- Social activities range from bingo, coffee mornings, and social evenings. In addition a mobile library visits the scheme once a month.

Description of the property

Rectory Court, built in 1966, is a two-storey building containing 11 studio flats and 4 one bedroom flats and one 2 bed flat which will be for people with high level medical needs who will need a 24 hour carer, or for example, a brother or sister (both meeting the age criteria) or other simialr relationships.

There are also 9 one bedroom bungalows. Each property has its own bathroom and WC.



Rose Gardens, built in 1960, is made up of 2 purpose built blocks arranged on 2 storeys.

There are 16 studio flats and 1 two bedroom flat which will be for people with high level medical needs who will need a 24 hour carer, or for example, a brother or sister (both meeting the age criteria) or other similar relationships.

Each property has an individual bathroom and WC.

This scheme has a non-resident Scheme Manager who resides in a neighbouring unit at Moss Gardens. The manager covers both these schemes on a daily basis.

Location and transport information

Rose Gardens is located on a small estate off Feltham High Street and close to Feltham Green. Buses run along Feltham High Street to several destinations, including Hounslow and Brentford (bus nos. 117,H25 & H26). Feltham Rail Station is approximately 10 minutes walk away. Hatton Cross

Rose Gardens Feltham TW13 4JG

Underground Station can be reached in approximately 15 minutes on the number 90 bus.

Rose Gardens is within easy reach of local shops and Feltham High Street. A Post Office is located nearby in Spring Road.


The nearest Health Centre is on Manor Lane and the nearest hospital is Ashford & St Peter's in Ashford.
